### SUBJECT AND DATE OF EXAM

### ARRANGEMENTS

The above named subject voluntarily submitted to a polygraph examination administered by Paul Redden at State of California High Desert Prison, 475 Rice Canyon Road, Susanville, California 96127.

The examination utilized a Lafayette computerized polygraph instrument which indicated and recorded relative changes in blood pressure, rate and strength of pulse beat, galvanic skin response and breathing pattern.

It was the understanding of the examiner that the primary purpose of this examination was to determine the truthfulness of the subject's statement when he denied that he was able to identify the person who shot him and his friend, DeAnthony Williams, on September 9, 1993..

The subject stated that DeAnthony Williams was a good friend of his and that he had known him since the 8<sup>th</sup> grade in school. On the day in question he was walking to school and stopped by DeAnthony's residence on the way. DeAnthony was showing him where a shooting had taken place the previous evening when a car drove by and heard bangs coming from the car. He and DeAnthony started running and he stopped to see if someone was shooting off firecrackers. When he stopped he was shot in the front torso area of his body and he could see DeAnthony lying on the ground. He said that he fell on the steps of an apartment and an ambulance took him to the hospital. He was questioned by police and told them he did not see who did the shooting. Landu said that everything happened so fast that he did not see the car and did not see the shooter. He first told police that he did not

know who the shooter was. Landu said that he was later questioned by police and they told him they knew who did the shooting. They told him that John Smith was the shooter. Landu said that police showed him a photo line-up and he picked John Smith as the shooter because he knew John Smith from school. He said that he later tried to tell police that he did not see who shot him but they would not listen to him. Mvuemba said that he did not see the color or make of car that was used in the shooting and did not see or know who the person was that shot him.

During the course of the six administered polygraph examinations the following relevant questions were asked:

### **RELEVANT QUESTIONS**

Charts 1 – 2:

1. Were you being honest when you identified John Smith as the person who shot you and DeAnthony Williams ?

SUBJECT answered: “No.”

2. Did you knowingly lie in court when you testified that you saw John Smith shoot you and DeAnthony Williams? ?

SUBJECT answered: “Yes”

These questions appeared to be confusing to the subject and were changed to the following:

Charts 3 – 6:

1. Did you see John Smith shoot you and Anthony Williams?

SUBJECT answered: “No.”

2. On 9/9/93 did you observe John Smith fire a gun at you and DeAnthony Williams?

SUBJECT answered: “No.”

**RESULTS**

At the conclusion of the polygraph examination a careful evaluation of all the subject's polygraph charts revealed physiological responses generally associated with truthfulness. It is my opinion, as the examiner, based on a careful analysis of all the subject's polygraph charts that the subject was not attempting deception when he answered "no" to the above relevant questions and did not see the person who shot he and DeAnthony Williams on September 9, 1993.
